**RE: FREEDOM OF INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY ACT (the "Act")  
REQUEST FOR ACCESS TO RECORDS  
OUR FILE REFERENCE: 2010-G-0004**

Further to our letter of May 14, 2010, the Energy Resources Conservation Board ("ERCB") has processed your request to access the following information:

Revenue and expense information for the General Well Data File which is described on page 30 of the ERCB's 2010 Catalogue of Publications, Maps and Services. Revenue should be organized so it's clear how much can be attributed to the Initial Fee and how much can be attributed to Annual Subscriptions. The expense information should include items which are directly relevant to the sale of the data as described in the Catalogue. (Fiscal years 2007, 2008 and 2009 and budget for 2010).

## **ACCESS DECISION**

Pursuant to section 10 the *Act*, the public body (the ERCB) is obligated to assist an applicant by creating a record to respond to a request that would not unreasonably interfere with the operations of the public body. Accordingly, the ERCB has created a record (attached) that has broken down revenue for the fiscal years 2007/2008 to 2009/2010 and shows all subscription fees and initial fees separately that are available at this time. With regard to expenses, the ERCB does not track actual expenses at the individual product levels. Fees charged by the ERCB for catalogue items are based generally on the cost recovery principle. The ERCB does not have specific cost allocations for individual catalogue products (ie. the General Well Data File).

## **REVIEW PROVISIONS**

Section 65 of the *Act* allows you to ask the Information and Privacy Commissioner to review the ERCB decision regarding these requests. The *Act* allows you 60 days from the date of this notice

to request a review by writing to the Information and Privacy Commissioner at 410, 9925 – 109<sup>th</sup> Street, Edmonton, Alberta T5K 2J8.

Section 67(1) of the *Act* requires the Commissioner to give a copy of your request for review to the head of a public body and to any other person who, in the Commissioner's opinion, is affected by the request. Therefore, your request for review should not contain any information that you do not wish exchanged with other parties.

If you wish to request a review, please provide the Office of the Commissioner with the following information:

1. The ERCB FOIP request number quoted at the top of this letter.
2. A copy of this letter.
3. A copy of your original request for information that you sent to the ERCB.

This concludes our production of records pursuant to your request to access information.
